THE SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE AUTHORITY-ESTABLISHMENT, UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on First Appeal dated 18.03.2025, preferred by S.L. Goel, Advocate, chamber No. 422, District Court, Sector-43, Chandigarh, under RTI Act 2005, through registered post, against the disposal of his RTI Application dated 18.01.2025 by CPIO/Establishment, vide letter No. 20/RTI-25/CPIO/Estt. UT/5633 dated 04.02.2025.

- (2) The appellant, vide his application dated 18.01.2025 under RTI Act 2005, had requested CPIO to supply him some information in 04 points related to assets owned by Mrs. Gurjit Kaur, Dy. Supdt. Of Police, Chandigarh Police. Incharge, Public Window (PHQ)-cum-CAPIO, PHQ, Sector-09, Chandigarh has transferred the application to CPIO/Establishment for its proper disposal vide no. 49/RTI/CAPIO(PHQ)/UT/PWS dated 21.01.2025. Furthermore, DSP/HQs.-cum-CPIO/Esttb. disposed off the RTI application on 04.02.2025.
- (3) The appellant, not satisfied with the information supplied by the CPIO against his RTI application and has filed the instant appeal to provide right information.
- (4) Comments of CPIO/Establishment have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Establishment. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:-

Point No. 01 Copies of Immovable property returns (IPRs) filed by Mrs. Gurjit Kaur, for the years 2010 onwards (till date) Point No. 02 Copies of the request letters for permission to purchase of moveable and immoveable properties, during the years 2010 onwards. Point No. 03 Copies of the permission letter issued in respect of the requests mentioned at b) above. It has been found that the instant appeal was filed by the appellant after the prescribed period for filing an appeal had elapsed. As per the RTI Act, an appeal should be filed within thirty days from either the date on which the 30-day period for the supply of information expires or the date on which the information or decision of the Public Information Officer is received. Furthermore, the undersigned has noted that the CPIO, in his comments, mentioned that Mrs. Gurjit Kaur, Deputy Superintendent of Police, submitted a written request stating that her personal information should be withheld from disclosure

in accordance with the exemptions provided under the RTI Act, 2005.

In view of the above, no further action is required in this matter. The appeal is hereby disposed off, accordingly.

(5) The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal to the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
