ORDER

The attached appeal has been received from Sh. Shivendra Pal R/O # 100, Sector-23-A, Chandigarh through speed post and the same endorsed in this office vide No. 22/UT/RTI/FAA/SP dated 10.08.2021 for further proceeding under RTI Act-2005. The appellant has preferred this 1st appeal against the reply/order of Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO/CCIC in connection with his RTI application dated 09.07.2021 with the contentions that Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO/CCIC did not make available/supply the copy of complaint No. PW-202112251.

INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-

The applicant had asked to supply him the copy of complaint No. PW-202112251 filed by Mr. Sanjit Singh Bala against him.

REPLY/COMMENTS OF DY.S.P-CUM-CPIO/CCIC IN CONNECTION WITH RTI APPLICATION:-

Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO/CCIC had submitted reply of the RTI application of the applicant on 30.07.2021. The contents of the reply of Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO/CCIC to the RTI application are read as under:

1.		The complaint vide PW-202112251 is under Investigation in Cyber Crime Investigation Cell, Sector-17, Chandigarh. Hence, the requisite information is denied u/s 8(1(h) of RTI Act-2005.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, reply/comments submitted by Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO/CCIC to the RTI application, appeal of the appellant and comments submitted by Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO/CCIC vis-à-vis material available on record. The consideration view of material available on record revealed that that Mr Shivendra Pal, applicant had filed an application under RTI Act wherein he had asked to supply him copy of complaint No. PW-202112251 filed by Mr. Sanjit Singh Bala against him. This complaint is still under enquiry with Cyber Crime Investigation Cell, Sector-17, Chandigarh and Mr Shivendra Pal (Applicant/appellant) is an alleged in this complaint. Till completion of enquiry, the copy of complaint can't supply to the applicant/appellant, thus I am on the consideration view that Dy.S.P-Cum-CPIO/CCIC has disposed off RTI application of the applicant appropriately.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067, under the RTI Act within 90 days.
