ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 10.05.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 10.04.2024by CPIO/South with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 10.04.2024 had sought copy of complaint no. ICMS/2024/004323 dated 14.02.2024 registered against him.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South:-

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS- 31 who reported that complaint in question is still under enquiry. Hence, sought information was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8(1) (h) of RTI Act, 2005. Applicant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 98/RTI-24/CPIO-South dated 20.04.2024.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought copy of complaint no. ICMS/2024/004323 dated 14.02.2024 registered against him.

In reply, CPIO/South rightly denied the requisite information u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act as complaint in question is under enquiry.

So far as present status of this case is concerned, from the perusal of RTI and the contentions raised by the appellant, only copy of the complaint has been sought under RTI Act and providing the same will not hamper the process of enquiry. Therefore, CPIO/South is hereby directed to provide the copy of complaint to the appellant, if complaint is found related with the appellant, strictly as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
