ORDER

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal dated 17.05.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 21.03.2024 by CPIO/South with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 21.03.2024 had sought complete case file regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2023/019590.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South:-

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the requisite information and reported that no such RTI application dated 21.03.2024 of the appellant has been received in this office.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought complete case file regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2023/019590.

In reply, CPIO/South has appraised that no such RTI application has been received of the appellant.

So far as present appeal is concerned, appellant has iterated that he has preferred RTI application dated 21.03.2024 but no such RTI application has been received with the Police department and also appellant has not produced any substantial document to prove that his RTI application was received with Police department. Therefore, considering the above facts, CPIO/South is hereby directed to carefully examine the record and if such RTI application is found, then consider the same, as per the RTI Act.

Moreover, if no correspondence is made by the CPIO/South within a week then, appellant is advised to apply a fresh RTI application.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
