**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal against the reply/order of CPIO/South in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 138/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 07.12.2021 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

**INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-**

Appellant had sought information on three points regarding to FIR No. 152 dated 30.07.2018 lodged at PS-49, Chandigarh i.e. copy of FIR, copy of Complaint (Tehrir) dated 30.07.2018 etc.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/South: -**

CPIO/South submitted that application of the appellant was received online for supplying requisite information. After obtaining the requisite information from SHO-49, requisite information was denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act as FIR in question is still under investigation. Appellant has been apprised vide memo no. 536/CPIO/South dated 25.10.2021.

**DECISION:-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had sought information on three points regarding to FIR No. 152 dated 30.07.2018 lodged at PS-49, Chandigarh i.e. copy of FIR, copy of Complaint (Tehrir) dated 30.07.2018 etc.

In reply CPIO/South denied the requisite information u/s 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act, however; from perusal of RTI application it is clear that appellant has sought same information i.e. copy of complaint in different ways, therefore; copy of FIR can be supplied to the appellant which includes all points within itself.

Hence, CPIO/South is hereby directed to provide the copy of FIR to the appellant.  
Appeal stands disposed of, accordingly.

With these directions, appeal stands disposed of.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
