ORDER

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal against the reply of CPIO/PHQ in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 44/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 20.05.2021 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-

The appellant had sought information on 3 points with regard to complaint bearing No. 2021-05105 lodged by his client Ms. Manju i.e. status of complaint, copy of FIR, if any and copies of statements and documents produced by the parties during enquiry.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/PHQ: -

CPIO/PHQ submitted that appellant has sought information vide his RTI application dated 27.04.2021 pertaining to complaint No. 2021-05105. Thereafter, report from I/C CRU was obtained who submitted that complaint bearing No. 2021-05105 was under enquiry at that time. So the same was denied u/s 8(1) (h) of RTI Act. As far as appeal is concerned, the same is still under consideration.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/PHQ vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had sought information on 3 points pertaining to complaint bearing No. 2021-05105 lodged by his client Ms. Manju i.e. status of complaint, copy of FIR, if any and copies of statements and documents produced by the parties during enquiry.

Whereas, it is clear from the record in hand that complaint in question i.e. 2021-05105 is still under consideration for finalizing the same. Therefore, requisite information had rightly denied by CPIO/PHQ under section 8(1)(h) of RTI Act. Hence, no more action is warranted in the instant appeal and the same is hereby disposed of, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
