ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 17.03.2025 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 21.01.2025 by CPIO/East with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought copy of inquiry report dated 18.10.2023 pertaining to complaint bearing No. PW 2021-27950 alongwith all recorded statements.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/East :-

CPIO/East vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS-19, Chandigarh who reported that case FIR No. 53 dated 03.07.2024 U/s 420, 120-B IPC, PS-19, Chandigarh has been registered on the complaint bearing No. PW 2021-27950 and the same is under investigation. Hence, sought information was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act and the reply was sent to the applicant vide letter No. 07-RTI/CPIO/East/Chandigarh dated 21.02.2025.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought copy of inquiry report dated 18.10.2023 pertaining to complaint bearing No. PW 2021-27950 alongwith all recorded statements.

In reply, CPIO/East has denied the requisite information to the applicant, as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/East has appropriately disposed of the RTI application as case FIR No. 53 dated 03.07.2024 U/s 420, 120-B IPC, PS-19, Chandigarh has been registered on the complaint bearing No. PW 2021-27950 and the same is under investigation. Therefore, requisite information cannot be provided at this stage also.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
