ORDER

The appellant has preferred her 1st appeal dated 19.03.2025 against the disposal of her RTI application dated 11.02.2025 by CPIO/South with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to her.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide her RTI application had sought information on 04 points i.e. Details of the day to day action taken by the Police to findout/ locate the taxi mentioned above, from 19.12.2024 to till date, Date on which the taxi driver has been called to the Police Station, Details of action taken against the taxi owner and FIR registered against him and Name of Police official/ officers assigned to locate the offending vehicle.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS-49, Chandigarh who reported that the matter in question is still under inquiry with SI Hemant Kumar No. 1793/CHG, PS-49, Chandigarh. Hence, sought information was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act and the reply was sent to the applicant through online RTI Portal vide No. 22/RTI-25/CPIO-South/UT/Chandigarh dated 24.02.2025.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide her RTI application had sought information on 04 points i.e. Details of the day to day action taken by the Police to findout/ locate the taxi mentioned above, from 19.12.2024 to till date, Date on which the taxi driver has been called to the Police Station, Details of action taken against the taxi owner and FIR registered against him and Name of Police official/ officers assigned to locate the offending vehicle.

In reply, CPIO/South has denied the requisite information to the applicant, as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/South has appropriately disposed of the RTI application as the matter in question is still under consideration. Therefore, requisite information cannot be provided at this stage also.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
