ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 30.05.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 01.04.2024 by CPIO/Central with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 01.04.2024 had sought copy of FIR registered against Mr. Saurabh on the complaint of Sh. Ramesh Kumar DSP/Bhiwani at Police Station PS-03, Chandigarh.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Central:-

CPIO/Central vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS- 03 who reported that sought information is personal information as appellant is neither complainant nor alleged. Hence, the same was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8(1) (j) of RTI Act, 2005. Applicant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 88/RTI-24/CPIO-Central dated 03.05.2024.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought copy of FIR registered against Mr. Saurabh on the complaint of Sh. Ramesh Kumar DSP/Bhiwani at Police Station PS-03, Chandigarh.

In reply, CPIO/Central denied the sought information to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8(1) (j) of RTI Act, 2005.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/Central has appropriately denied the sought information to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (j) of RTI Act, as sought information is personal information as appellant is neither complainant nor

alleged in the FIR and no larger public interest would be served by disclosing such information to the appellant. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
