**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 20.03.2025 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 14.02.2025 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 02 points i.e. provide the final outcome of report in respect of order of PCA dated 05.02.2025 addressed to SSP Chandigarh and provide the maximum time to be taken for this report.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-**

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from PCA Cell who reported that the matter in question is still under consideration. Hence, sought information was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act and on 20.03.2025, the reply was sent to the applicant through online RTI Portal vide No. 150/RTI-25/DSP/Admn dated 17.03.2025.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 02 points i.e. provide the final outcome of report in respect of order of PCA dated 05.02.2025 addressed to SSP Chandigarh and provide the maximum time to be taken for this report.

In reply, CPIO/Admn has denied the requisite information to the applicant, as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act.



Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/Admn has appropriately disposed of the RTI application as the matter in question is still under consideration. Therefore, requisite information cannot be provided at this stage also.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
