**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 11.06.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 19.04.2024 by CPIO/South with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide his RTI application has sought information on 03 points regarding emergency call made on dated 05.04.2024 at 07:45 PM by the appellant i.e. certified copy of report submitted by PCR, certified copy of the complaint dated 05.04.2024 along with photographs taken by the police and action taken report along with the statements recorded by the police.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-**

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information from SHO-31 and point wise information was provided to the appellant. Applicant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 106/RTI-24/CPIO-South /Dated, 17.05.2024.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application has sought information on 03 points regarding emergency call made on dated 05.04.2024 at 07:45 PM by the appellant i.e. certified copy of report submitted by PCR, certified copy of the complaint dated 05.04.2024 along with photographs taken by the police and action taken report along with the statements recorded by the police.

In reply, CPIO/South has provided the copy of the complaint to the appellant and denied rest of the information as per the provision of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act, as complaint in question is under enquiry.

Now, as far as appeal is concerned, a similar first appeal was transferred to this by SP/Hqrs-cum-Appellant Authority/Communication vide no. D-464-467/RTI/SP/Hqrs. dated 29.05.2024. The same was disposed off well within the prescribed period vide order no. D-192-194/UT/RTI/SSP dated 20.06.2024 and appellant was apprised, accordingly. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this instant appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
