#### ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 24.03.2025 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 27.02.2025 by CPIO/South-West with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

## Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought copy of documents given by Gamdoor Singh, Gurmeet Kaur, Gursharan Singh, etc at Police Station Maloya on threat perception in CRWP 4248-2024.

### COMMENTS OF CPIO/South-West :-

CPIO/South-West vide his comments submitted that the RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS-Maloya and the same was denied to the applicant U/s 8 (1) (j) of RTI Act, information being third party. The reply was sent to the applicant through online RTI Portal vide office letter No. 41/RTI/CPIO/South-West dated 24.03.2025.

#### **DECISION:-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South-West vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought copy of documents given by Gamdoor Singh, Gurmeet Kaur, Gursharan Singh, etc at Police Station Maloya on threat perception in CRWP 4248-2024

In reply, CPIO/South-West has denied the sought information as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (j) of RTI Act, information being third party to the appellant through online RTI Portal vide office letter No. 41/RTI/CPIO/South-West dated 24.03.2025

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, appellant has raised contentions that he himself is a party in the sought reference. Therefore, considering the same, CPIO/South-West is hereby directed to provide the requisite information to the applicant, if the same is found directly related with him, strictly as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
