ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 13.12.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 26.10.2024 by CPIO/East with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application has sought certified copy of visitor register from 21.09.2024 tp 30.09.2024 of PS-19, Chandigarh and CCTV camera footage from 21.09.2024 to 30.09.2024 of gate/entrypoint, waiting room & SHO room of PS-19, Chandigarh.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/East :-

CPIO/East vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO- 19 and the same was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 2 (F) of RTI Act, information being vague in nature. Accordingly, appellant was apprised vide letter No. 207/RTI-24/CPIO-South dated 18.11.2024.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application has sought certified copy of visitor register from 21.09.2024 tp 30.09.2024 of PS-19, Chandigarh and CCTV camera footage from 21.09.2024 to 30.09.2024 of gate/entrypoint, waiting room & SHO room of PS-19, Chandigarh.

In reply, CPIO/East has denied the sought information per the section 2 (f) of RTI Act, information being vague in nature.

Now, as far as the appeal is concerned, sought information (copy of visitor register from 21.09.2024 tp 30.09.2024 of PS-19, Chandigarh and CCTV camera footage from 21.09.2024 to 30.09.2024 of gate/entrypoint, waiting room & SHO room of PS-19, Chandigarh), CPIO/East has inappropriately denied the requisite information by applying section 2(F) of RTI Act. However, from the perusal of RTI application it is clear that appellant has sought details

being 07 days long, which will not only include his sought information which he has not mentioned specifically but all other activities of Police Station, hence, the same can not be p. Jvided to the appellant as per provisions of section 8(1) (g) & (j) of RTI act, as the disclosure of the same would endanger the life and physical safety of any person or disclose the identity of the source of information or assistance given in confidence of law enforcement or security purpose.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
