ORDER

The appellant has preferred online 1st appeal bearing no. PODEP/A/E/24/00043 dated 18.06.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application bearing no. PODEP/R/E/24/00331 dated 19.05.2024 by CPIO/Hqrs with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application:-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 19.05.2024 has sought information on 05 points i.e. copy of reply given by ASI Vijay Kumar in order issued by PSHRC on dated 01.12.2023 or reference DDR no. 0004, reply given by ASI Vijay Kumar as per DDR No. 0004 as how is it possible that complaint no. PW202207500 is still running in record after it was withdrawn or filed, reply given by ASI Vijay Kumar against the kidnapping video, why was his medical not conducted and kindly share the complete investigation report of complaint no. ICMS/2024/013718.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Hars :-

CPIO/Hqrs vide his comments submitted that RTI application was received in his office to obtain requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC who reported that complaint no. PW-202207500 is consigned with HAC Branch. Appellant was informed to collect the same vide letter No. 302/CPIO/Hqrs/RTI-2024, D-413 & 119/CPIO/Hqrs/Online RTI-24 dated 06.06.2024. However, appellant has not visited the office till date to collect the same. Moreover, information in the shape of 21 pages regarding complaint no. PW-202207500 has already been provided to the appellant vide no. 42/CPIO/Hqrs/Online RTI-24 dated 13.03.2024.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Hqrs vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application has sought information on 05 points i.e. copy of reply given by ASI Vijay Kumar in order issued by PSHRC on dated 01.12.2023 or reference DDR no. 0004, reply given by ASI Vijay Kumar as per DDR No. 0004 as how is it possible that complaint no. PW202207500 is still running in record after it was withdrawn or filed, reply given by ASI Vijay Kumar against the kidnapping video, why was his medical not conducted and kindly share the complete investigation report of complaint no. ICMS/2024/013718.

In reply, CPIO/Hqrs has already communicated the appellant to visit the office and collect the requisite information.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, appellant has sought information regarding Case diary no. 15652 dated 14.05.2024 of Punjab State Human Rights Commission, however, CPIO/Hqrs has inadvertently disposed of this RTI application by considering his previous RTI information regarding complaint no. PW-202207500. Therefore, considering the contentions raised by the appellant and going through the RTI application of the appellant, CPIO/Hqrs is hereby directed to re-consider the RTI application and provide the sought information to the appellant as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
