**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 27.03.2025 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 26.02.2025 by CPIO/South with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought status of action taken on recommendation given by PCA on 05<sup>th</sup> February 2025 against the officer Jaspal Singh and others with file bearing No. 19/19.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-**

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that the RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. From the perusal of record, it is found that the report regarding the sought information has been prepared and sent to senior officers on 19.03.2025. The applicant was apprised about the same through online RTI Portal vide office letter No. 31/RTI-25/CPIO-South/Chandigarh dated 26.03.2025.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought status of action taken on recommendation given by PCA on 05<sup>th</sup> February 2025 against the officer Jaspal Singh and others with file bearing No. 19/19.

In reply, CPIO/South has apprised the current status of the case to the appellant vide office letter No. 31/RTI-25/CPIO-South/Chandigarh dated 26.03.2025.



Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/South has already provided the requisite information sought by the applicant vide office letter No. 31/RTI-25/CPIO-South/Chandigarh dated 26.03.2025. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this instant 1<sup>st</sup> appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
