The appellant has preferred 1st appeal against the disposal of his RTI application dated 03.04.2023 by CPIO/North-East and Hqrs. with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application:-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 03.04.2023 had sought information on five (05) points regarding complaints bearing No. ICMS/2022/011742 and ICMS/2023/000224 i.e. certified copy of all notings, certified copy of final decision, copy of statements, copy of documents, certified copy of complaints, Copy of FIR if registered etc.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/North-East :-

CPIO/North-East vide his comments submitted that RTI application was received in his office to obtain information regarding complaints bearing No. ICMS/2022/011742 and ICMS/2023/000224. Accordingly, requisite comments were obtained from SHO Police Station Mani-Majra who reported that complaints in question were sent to I/C CRU after completion of enquiry. Therefore, RTI application was also transferred to CPIO/Hqrs. vide no. 52-RTI/CPIO/North-East/Dated, Chandigarh, the: 07.04.2023 as per the provisions of Section 6(3) of RTI Act.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Hqrs :-

CPIO/Hqrs. vide his comments submitted that RTI application was received in his office from CPIO/North-East vide letter No. 52-RTI/CPIO/North-East/Dated, Chandigarh, the: 07.04.2023 to obtain information regarding complaints bearing No. ICMS/2022/011742 and ICMS/2023/000224. Accordingly, comments were obtained from I/C CRU who reported that complaints in question are

under consideration for finalization, Accordingly, the sought information was denied to the applicant as per provisions of section 8(1)(h) of RTI Act, 2005 vide letter No. 193/CPIO/Hqrs/OnlineRTI023, D-304 Dated 19.04.2023.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Hqrs. and CPIO/North-East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant has sought information on five (05) points regarding complaints bearing No. ICMS/2022/011742 and ICMS/2023/000224 i.e. certified copy of all notings, certified copy of final decision, copy of statements, copy of documents, certified copy of complaints, Copy of FIR if registered etc.

In reply, CPIO/Hqrs denied the requisite information u/s 8(1) (h) of RTI Act, as the complaints were under consideration/enquiry at that stage.

So far as the present status of the complaints is concerned, as per the record of ICMS portal the same has been sent back to SHO Police Station Mani-Majra for further inquiry. Hence, the complete information cannot be supplied at this stage also and the same is denied u/s 8(1) (h) of RTI Act.

However, as appellant himself is complainant in the above mentioned complaints, so, CPIO/North-East is hereby directed to supply the copy of complaints to the appellant as per RTI act. He is further directed to expedite the enquiry and supply the requisite information to the appellant in accordance with RTI act as and when enquiry will be finalized. With these observation the instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
