ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 18.07.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 26.06.2024 by CPIO/Hqrs with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application:-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 26.06.2024 has sought information on 17 points regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2024/005027 i.e. certified copy of complaint, certified copy of noting portions, certified copy of summons, certified copy of complainant's statements, copy of summons sent to Sh. Shambhu Rathee, certified copy of Shambhu Rathee's statements, copy of summons sent to Smt. Manisha, copy of statement of Smt. Manisha, copy of summons sent to Sh. Hari Singh, copy of statement of Sh. Hari Singh, copy of summons sent to Sh. Shashank, copy of statement of Sh. Shashank, copy of certified copy of summons sent of MC officials, copy of statements of MC officials, name of IO, certified copy of other documents and inspection of file.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Hgrs :-

CPIO/Hqrs vide his comments submitted that RTI application was received in his office to obtain information regarding complaint bearing No. ICMS/2024/005027. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC and after the inspection of the complaint file, available information in the shape of 07 pages regarding points no. 01 to 04 & 15 to 17 was provided to the appellant vide letter No. 400/CPIO/Hqrs/RTI-2024, D-553 Dated 12.07.2024 and information regarding points no. 05 to 14 is not available in the record.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Hqrs vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed

that the appellant has sought on 17 points regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2024/005027 i.e. certified copy of complaint, certified copy of noting portions, certified copy of summons, certified copy of complainant's statements, copy of summons sent to Sh. Shambhu Rathee, certified copy of Shambhu Rathee's statements, copy of summons sent to Smt. Manisha, copy of statement of Smt. Manisha, copy of summons sent to Sh. Hari Singh, copy of statement of Sh. Hari Singh, copy of statement of Sh. Shashank, copy of statement of Sh. Shashank, copy of statements of MC officials, name of IO, certified copy of other documents and inspection of file.

In reply, CPIO/Hqrs has already provided the available information in the shape of 07 pages, after providing an opportunity of inspection to the appellant.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, appellant has raised contentions that correct and required information was not provided to him. In this regard, CPIO/Hqrs has appropriately disposed off the RTI application by provided the sought information to the appellant after giving him opportunity of inspection of file. Moreover, only such information can be provided by the CPIO, which is available in the record. Hence, no more action is required on this first appeal.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
