## ORDER

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal (bearing PODEP/A/E/21/00050 dated 28.06.2021) against the reply of CPIO/Central in connection with his RTI application (bearing No. PODEP/R/E/21/00264 dated 12.05.2021) with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. This appeal was diarized vide No. 57/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 28.06.2021 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

#### INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-

The appellant has sought information on 05 points pertaining to his complaint bearing No. 2021-04614 i.e. copies of statements and final report.

### COMMENTS OF CPIO/CENTRAL: -

CPIO/Central submitted that appellant has sought information through online RTI application. Thereafter, report from SHO/PS-17 who

reported that the complaint in question i.e. 2021-04614 was under enquiry, therefore, the same was denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act. As far as appeal is concerned, the said complaint is under consideration with him therefore, the same cannot be supplied presently.

#### **DECISION:-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had sought information on 05 points pertaining to his complaint bearing No. 2021-04614 i.e. copies of statements and final report.

Insofar appeal is concerned, it is clear that complaint in question 2021-04614 is still under consideration with SDPO/Central, therefore, requisite information i.e. final report and copy of statement cannot be supplied at this stage u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act. However, considering that appellant is complainant in this complaint, therefore, copy of his statement(s) can be supplied at this stage. Hence, instant appeal of appellant is hereby disposed of with the direction to CPIO/Central to supply copy of statement of appellant forthwith, free of cost, as per RTI Act.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
