ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 09.04.2025 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 04.04.2025 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 04 points in regard to complaint bearing No. ICMS/2022/002642 i.e. Total pages in complaint, detail of annexure C-1 to C-7, statement of Aasha Devi and to provide the reason of delay in finalization of the said complaint.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, the requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC and on 04.04.2025, after scrutiny of original file, pointwise reply was sent to the appellant through registered post vide office letter No. 163/RTI-25/DSP/Admn dated 04.04.2025.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 04 points in regard to complaint bearing No. ICMS/2022/002642 i.e. Total pages in complaint, detail of annexure C-1 to C-7, statement of Aasha Devi and to provide the reason of delay in finalization of the said complaint.

In reply, CPIO/Admn provided the available information to the appellant through registered post vide office letter No. 163/RTI-25/DSP/Admn dated 04.04.2025.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/Admn has appropriately disposed of the RTI application by providing the available information to the appellant. However, appellant has now raised queries regarding enquiry of the complaint, which is non-maintainable under RTI Act, as only available information in the record can be supplied to the applicant and no information can be created by the CPIO at its own end.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
