ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 07.06.2023 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 02.05.2023 by CPIO/Hqrs with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 02.05.2023 had sought information on two (02) points regarding complaint bearing No. PW 202205270 dated 14.03.2022 i.e. statements recorded during enquiry and latest status of investigation etc.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Hqrs :-

CPIO/Hqrs vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the CAPIO/PHQ from office his 372/RTI/CAPIO/PHQ/UT/PWS dated 03.05.2023 to obtain the information regarding received in complaint No. PW202205270. Accordingly, requisite information was obtained from I/C CRU who reported that complaint in question is under consideration for finalization. Hence, sought information was denied to the applicant as per provisions of section 8(1)(h) of RTI Act, 2005 vide letter No. 259/CPIO/Hqrs/Online/RTI-23/ D-382 Dated 24.05.2023.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Hqrs vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on two (02) points regarding complaint bearing No. PW 202205270 dated 14.03.2022 i.e. statements recorded during enquiry and latest status of investigation etc.

In reply, CPIO/Hqrs had denied the requisite information to the appellant u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act as the complaint in question was under consideration/enquiry at that stage.

So far as the present status of the complaint is concerned, the same is still under consideration for finalization. Hence, the complete documents/information cannot be supplied at this stage also and the same is denied u/s 8(1) (h) of RTI Act. However, in the interest of justice, CPIO/Hqrs is hereby directed to supply the requisite information to the appellant in accordance with RTI act as and when the enquiry into the complaint is finalized.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
