ORDER

This is an order on the application dated 18.07.2024 filed by the petitioner Ms. Navjot Lehal before the Hon'ble Chandigarh Right to Service Commission, UT Chandigarh (Petition No. 05 of 2024-2025) with the allegations for non-registration of FIR on her complaint. The Hon'ble Commission vide order No. MS/CRTSC/2024/139 dated 25.07.2024, in the continuation of Commission's orders bearing No. MS/CRTSC/2024/76 dated 17.05.2024 and MS/CRTSC/2024/100 dated 12.06.2024, has referred the instant case to the undersigned for taking appropriate action.

COMMENTS OF SHO PS 19:-

Before proceeding further, comments of Designated Officer-cum-SHO PS 19 has been obtained who submitted that a complaint bearing No. ICMS/2024/14149 was registered on the application filed by the petitioner Ms. Navjot Lehal against Mr. Krishan Kumar alleging non implementation of Right to Service Act in the office of Registrar Coop. Societies, UT, Chandigarh. Accordingly, the complaint has been sent to Vigilance department, UT, Chandigarh for further course of action at their own level.


DECISION :-

I have gone through the complaint as well as instant petition, comments of -SHO- 19, Chandigarh vis-à-vis material available on record thoroughly

which revealed that a complaint bearing No. ICMS/2024/14149 was registered on the application filed by the petitioner Ms. Navjot Lehal against Mr. Krishan Kumar alleging non implementation of Right to Service Act in the office of Registrar Coop. Societies, UT, Chandigarh.

As per comments of Designated Officer-cum-SHO PS-19 Area that it is clear that the complaint in question, has already been sent to Vigilance department, UT, Chandigarh for further course of action at their own end, so applicant may liaise with the Vigilance department for any future references.

With these observations, instant petition stands disposed off, accordingly
