ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal through online RTI portal vide no. PODEP/A/E/22/00075 dated 25.06.2022 against the disposal of his RTI application bearing no. PODEP/R/E/22/00437 dated 15.06.2022 by CPIO/East with contentions that the requisite information was refused to him.

INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION :-

The appellant vide his RTI application bearing no. PODEP/R/E/22/00437 dated 15.06.2022 had sought case FIR number related to the suicide case of Meenakshi Yadav wife of Sh. Nitin Kumar Yadav, IAS.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/East :-

Comments of CPIO/East have been obtained who submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office through online RTI portal vide no. PODEP/R/E/22/00437 dated 15.06.2022 for supplying case FIR number related to the suicide case of Meenakshi Yadav wife of Sh. Nitin Kumar Yadav, IAS. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS Sector 19 and the same was denied to the appellant u/s 8(1)(g & j) of RTI act vide letter dated 21.06.2022, being third party and personal information, disclosure of which has no relevancy to any public activity or interest.

DECISION :-


I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the requisite information was denied by CPIO/East u/s 8(1)(g & j) of RTI act, being third party and personal information, disclosure of which has no relevancy to any public activity or interest.

For proper disposal of the instant appeal, appellant as well as CPIO/East were called for personal hearing fixed for 01.08.2022 vide letter no. D-264-265/UT/RTI/SSP dated 29.07.2022. On the request of the appellant received through e-mail dated 29.07.2022, personal hearing was deferred for 08.08.2022 vide letter no. D-266-267/UT/RTI/SSP dated 30.07.2022 mentioning therein that if appellant failed to appear for personal hearing, the appeal will be decided ex-parte. Thereafter, appellant has again sent an e-mail on dated 01.08.2022

stating therein that he will not be able to attend the in-person hearing and submitted some arguments.

In view of above, instant appeal is being decided ex-parte. The RTI application of the appellant was rightly decided by the CPIO/East hence, no more action is required to be taken on the instant appeal and the same stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeals, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
