ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 20.12.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 06.11.2024 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought certified copy of complaint no. ICMS/2024/024386 along wilth all statements and action taken report.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn.:-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from concerned I/C CRU who reported that complaint in question i.e. ICMS/2024/024386 is under consideration. Hence, sought information was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act and applicant was apprised vide letter no. 424/RTI-24/DSP/Admn dated 13.11.2024.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought certified copy of complaint no. ICMS/2024/024386 along wilth all statements and action taken report.

In reply, CPIO/Admn has provided the copy of the complaint and denied rest of the information to the applicant, as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/Admn has appropriately disposed of the RTI application. Moreover, complaint in question is still under consideration. Therefore, requisite information cannot be provided at this stage also. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this on this instant 1st appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
