### ORDER

The appellant has preferred her online 1<sup>st</sup> appeal bearing No. PODEP/A/E/23/00054 dated 02.07.2023 against the disposal of her online RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/23/00430 dated 23.05.2023 by CPIO/East with the contentions that requisite information were not provided to him.

## Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 23.05.2023 had sought information related to her complaints bearing Nos. ICMS/2022/003120, ICMS/2022/003121, ICMS/2023/001675 and ICMS/2023/001878 sent through e-mail id. <a href="mailto:Anuradhagarg13@gmail.com">Anuradhagarg13@gmail.com</a> i.e. copy of complaints, statements, documents on record, action taken and reason for not registering FIR on complaints etc.

#### COMMENTS OF CPIO/East :-

CPIO/East vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to obtain the information regarding her complaints. Accordingly, requisite information was obtained from SHO Police Station Sector 26, who reported that complaints in question i.e. ICMS/2022/003120, ICMS/2022/003121, ICMS/2023/001675 and ICMS/2023/001878 were under enquiry at that time. Hence, sought information was denied to the applicant as per provisions of section 8(1)(h) of RTI Act, 2005 vide letter No. 126-RTI/CPIO/East/Dated, Chandigarh, the: 15.06.2023. As far as the present status of complaints are concerned, the same are still under consideration.

#### **DECISION:-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information related to her complaints bearing Nos. ICMS/2022/003120, ICMS/2022/003121, ICMS/2023/001675 and ICMS/2023/001878 sent

through e-mail id. <u>Anuradhagarg13@gmail.com</u> i.e. copy of complaints, statements, documents on record, action taken and reason for not registering FIR on complaints etc.

In reply, CPIO/East had denied the requisite information to the appellant u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act as the complaints in questions were under enquiry at that stage.

So far as the instant appeal is concerned, complaints in question are still under enquiry. Hence, the complete documents/information cannot be supplied at this stage also and the same is denied u/s 8(1) (h) of RTI Act. It is also pertinent to mention here that appellant has raised her grievances regarding the delay in registering the FIR, process of enquiry and favouring the accused etc., which does not falls under the purview of RTI act, 2005. Only information available in record can be provided to the appellant. However, CPIO/East is hereby directed to provide the copy of complaint to the appellant and supply the rest of the requisite information to the appellant as and when final decision is taken on the above mentioned complaints, in accordance with RTI act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of her appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
