**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 18.12.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 10.12.2024 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2024/029342 i.e. Ms. Neha Kanojia's statement, summon and proof attached.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn.:-**

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from concerned I/C CRU who reported that complaint in question i.e. ICMS/2024/029342 is under consideration. Hence, sought information was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act and applicant was apprised vide letter no. 505/RTI-24/DSP/Admn dated 16.12.2024.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing no. ICMS/2024/029342 i.e. Ms. Neha Kanojia's statement, summon and proof attached.

In reply, CPIO/Admn has denied the sought information to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, as per the record of ICMS portal the complaint in question has now been consigned with HAC branch after the finalization of

the enquiry. Therefore, CPIO/Admn is hereby directed to provide the sought information to the appellant as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
