ORDER

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal against the reply of CPIO/South in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The appeal was diarized vide No. 86/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 25.08.2021 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-

The appellant has sought information on 3 points pertaining to complaint No. 2021-07947 i.e. complete case file & action taken report etc.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/SOUTH: -


CPIO/South submitted that appellant has sought information through RTI application. Thereafter, report from SHO/PS 39 was obtained who reported that requisite information was denied to the appellant u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act as complaint is under enquiry stage. Appellant was informed in this regard vide No. 424/CPIO/South dated 20.08.2021.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had sought information on 3 points pertaining to complaint No. 2021-07947 i.e. complete case file & action taken report etc.

Insofar as appeal is concerned, it is clear that complaint in question i.e. PW No. 2021-07947 is still under enquiry, therefore, requisite information cannot be supplied at this stage, hence, CPIO/South had appropriately denied the requisite information u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act. However, considering that appellant is complainant in above complaint, thus, CPIO/South is hereby directed to supply the copy of complaint and statement of appellant and also verbally apprise/brief him about the current status of his enquiry. With above observations, instant appeal stands disposed of.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
