ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal in connection with his RTI application dated 05.08.2022 with the contentions that he has not received any information/reply from CPIO so far.

Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 05.08.2022 had sought status report and copy of statements etc recording during enquiry of complaint bearing PWS No. 2022-02410 dated 03.02.2022.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Central:

Comments of CPIO/Central have been obtained who submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office through CPIO/Hqrs vide his office No. 459/CPIO/Hqrs./RTI-2022,D-741 dated 01.09.2022 for supplying the information pertaining to complaint bearing PWS No.2022-02410 dated 03.02.2022. Thereafter, report from SHO/17 was sought who reported that the complaint bearing PWS No.2022-02410 dated 03.02.2022 was under enquiry so the requisite information was denied U/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act. This reply was dispatched at the given address of the appellant vide letter No. 250/RTI-22/CPIO-Central/UT/ dated 14.09.2022 through registered post but the same received back undelivered. In the meantime appellant filed the instant appeal on 14.09.2022. Further, on dated 22.09.2022 appellant visited the office of CPIO/Central and received the requisite information as per his satisfaction. He also given in writing that he has received all the requisite information and requested to file his RTI application dated 14.09.2022 (instant appeal).

Decision:

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application dated 05.08.2022 had sought status report and copy of statements etc recording during enquiry of complaint bearing PWS No.2022-02410 dated 03.02.2022. In response, CPIO/Central vide his office letter No. 250/RTI-22/CPIO-Central/UT/ dated 14.09.2022 declined the requisite information U/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act as the complaint in question was under enquiry at that time. The said letter was received back undelivered. Hence, disposal of CPIO/Central cannot be considered as delayed.

Thereafter, on dated 22.09.2022, appellant visited the office of CPIO/Central and received the requisite information as per his satisfaction. He also given in writing that he has received all the requisite information and requested to file his application dated 14.09.2022 (instant appeal). Hence, no more action is required to be taken on the instant appeal and the same is hereby treated to be filed as withdrawn.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, she can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
