**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 23.09.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 02.08.2024 by CPIO/South-West & CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide his RTI application has sought information on 12 points regarding complaints bearing no. ICMS/2023/023777 & ICMS/2023/024679 i.e. copy of DDRs, copy of colored map, copy of letter dated 01.12.2023, copy of photographs, date of visits of spot along with DDR copy, copy of notices, information regarding mode of calling of complainant, justification/clarification for not calling complainant, whether IO was present on duty, action taken on requests of complainant, details of legal advice taken from DDA and details of verbal discussions made.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-**

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC and the same was supplied to the applicant in the shape of 74 pages vide letter No. 25 & 41/CPIO/Admn Dated 30.08.2024.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-**

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from PS- Maloya and the same was supplied to the applicant in point wise manner vide letter No. 172-RTI/CPIO/South-West Dated 19.08.2024.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/S-West & Admn vis-à-vis material available on record

which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application has sought information on 12 points regarding complaints bearing no. ICMS/2023/023777 & ICMS/2023/024679 i.e. copy of DDRs, copy of colored map, copy of letter dated 01.12.2023, copy of photographs, date of visits of spot along with DDR copy, copy of notices, information regarding mode of calling of complainant, justification/clarification for not calling complainant, whether IO was present on duty, action taken on requests of complainant, details of legal advice taken from DDA and details of verbal discussions made.

In reply, CPIO/South-West & CPIO/Admn has already supplied the available information to the appellant.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, information pertaining to points no. (01, 02, 04, 07, 08, 09, 11 & 12), CPIO/South-West has already provided the sought information in point wise manner to the appellant, however, considering the contentions raised by the appellant has requested copy of colored map but instead a black and white color map was supplied to the appellant. Hence, CPIO/South-West is hereby directed to provided the colored copy of the map if the same is available in record as per the provisions of RTI Act.

Further, information pertaining to points no. (03, 05, 06 & 10), CPIO/Admn has already provided the sought information to the appellant in the shape of 74 pages. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this instant 1<sup>st</sup> appeal.

Moreover, appellant has now also raised contentions regarding transferring his RTI application to other CPIOs, which is non-maintainable.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
