ORDER

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal against the reply/order of CPIO/PHQ in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 94/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 09.09.2021 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-

The appellant had sought information regarding complaint filed by Sh. Parveen Bhardwaj to SSP/UT on 19.03.2015 i.e. Copy of complaint and inquiry report.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/PHQ: -

CPIO/PHQ submitted that application of the appellant was received for supplying requisite information and report from HAC Branch was obtained, who reported that complaint in question – 2015-04013 has already been destroyed vide order no. 6840-80/UT/HAC dated 17.09.2019.

In this regard appellant was apprised vide letter No. 394/CPIO/Hqrs/RTI-2021, D-475 dated 12.07.2021.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/PHQ vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant had sought information regarding complaint filed by Sh. Parveen Bhardwaj to SSP/UT on 19.03.2015 i.e. Copy of complaint and inquiry report.

Insofar as appeal is concerned, it is clear from the reply of CPIO/PHQ that complaint in question i.e. 2015-04013 has already been destroyed, hence, not available in record and CPIO is not in position to furnish the requisite information. However, copy of order vide which said record was destroyed, can be supplied at present.

Hence, CPIO/PHQ is hereby directed to supply the copy of destroyal order, free of cost, forthwith. The instant appeal is hereby disposed of.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of this appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
