

**THE SENIOR SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE HQs.-CUM-APPELLATE
AUTHORITY-ACCOUNTS, UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on an online appeal preferred by Sh. Jasleen S Vohra r/o H.No 416/A, New Police Lines, Sector-26, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005, received in this office through the RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System(RTI-MIS) bearing No. PODEP/A/E/23/00030 dated 01/04/2023, against the disposal of his online RTI Application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/23/00232 dated 29/03/2023 by DSP-cum-CPIO/Accounts.

(2) The appellant, vide his application dated 29/03/2023 under RTI Act 2005, had requested Nodal Officer-PHQ to supply information in 03 points in connection to pension case of his father Lt SI Avtar Singh No. 828/CHG. Nodal Officer/PHQ further transferred the online RTI application to DSP-cum-CPIO/Accounts for its proper disposal at his own level. CPIO/Accounts had disposed of the RTI application on 31/03/2023, vide No. 41/RTI/CPIO/Accounts/2023/ UT/11952.

(3) The appellant, being not satisfied with the manner CPIO/Accounts has disposed his RTI application, has filed the instant online appeal to provide complete information.


(4) Comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Accounts have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Accounts, the information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:-

I Ct Jasleen S Vohra 1929/CP joined Police force on 25.02.2019 on compassionate ground. I requested to sought information regarding my pension from 28.11.2018 to 24.02.2019 as there was no source of income and was below 25 year of age at that time. I requested you to please provide information regarding pending amount/arrears or objection made if any. 		pensioner). I also requested earlier about how long it will take as the matter is already delayed for more than four years. The matter does not belong to any third party and is of my own which is pending in your respected office. So therefore the said information may kindly be provided.
