## **ORDER**

The appellant has preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal on dated 18.10.2022 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 13.09.2022 by CPIO/South with the contentions that he has been supplied incomplete information.

## Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 13.09.2022 had sought information pertaining to complaint bearing PWS No. 2022-00177 dated 04.01.2022 i.e. copy of complaint and compromise, action taken on an application given by the applicant on 29.06.2021 in PS 49 etc.

## Comments of CPIO/South :-

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office on dated 14.09.2022 through CAPIO/PHQ vide letter No. 795/RTI/CAPIO/PHQ/UT/PWS dated 14.09.2022. Thereafter, requisite information was sought from SHO PS Sector 49, Chandigarh who reported that complaint bearing No. 2022-00177 dated 04.01.2022 was pending under consideration and supply of information at that stage would impede the process of enquiry, hence requisite information pertaining to this complaint was denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act vide letter No. 283/CPIO/South dated 16.09.2022. However, copies of complaint as well as compromise were supplied to the applicant along with this letter.

### Decision :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant vide point No. 01 of his RTI application, had sought only copies of complaint and compromise related to complaint No. PWS 2022-00177 dated 04.01.2022 and the same has already been supplied to him by CPIO. So far as the present status of this complaint is concerned, appellant is hereby intimated that as per office record, the same has been consigned to record after completion of enquiry. Hence, no more action is required to be taken with regard to point No. 01 of RTI application.

As far as the point No. 02 of RTI application is concerned, no reply/information has been supplied to the appellant in this regard by CPIO/South, henceforth, CPIO/South is hereby directed to re-consider the RTI application of the appellant with respect to point No. 02 and supply the available information to the appellant within ten days as per RTI act under intimation to this office.

With these observations/directions, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
