**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 04.11.2022 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 14.09.2022 by CPIO/PHQ with the contentions that incomplete information has not been supplied to him .

**Information sought vide RTI application :**

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 14.09.2022 had sought information on 4 points i.e. copy of complete file along with enquiry report, statements and other documents etc. pertaining to enquiry of a complaint bearing PWS No.2021-19893 dated 06.09.2021.

**Comments of CPIO/PHQ:-**

To proceed further in the matter, comments of CPIO/PHQ was sought, who submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office through CPIO/PHQ on 14.09.2022 for supplying information pertaining to a complaint bearing PWS No.2021-19893 dated 06.09.2021. As enquiry into this complaint was finalized and same was consigned in HAC branch, accordingly, relevant file was called from HAC branch u/s 5(4)(5) of RTI Act and appellant was informed to inspect the relevant file/record and collect requisite information from his office. Thereafter appellant visited the office of CPIO/PHQ and after inspecting the file thoroughly, collected the requisite information in the shape of four hundred thirty three (433) pages vide letter No.549/CPIO/Hqrs/RTI-22, dated 04.10.2022 under his signatures .


**Decision :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/PHQ vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that on receiving RTI application of the appellant for supplying information pertaining to a complaint bearing PWS No.2021-19893 dated 06.09.2021, relevant file was called by CPIO/PHQ from HAC branch and appellant was informed to collect the requisite information from his office after inspecting the file. Thereafter, appellant visited the office of CPIO/PHQ and after inspecting the file thoroughly, collected the requisite information in the shape of four hundred and thirty three (433) pages on dated 04.10.2022 under proper receipt.

As the available information has already been supplied by CPIO/PHQ to the appellant after offering inspection of the relevant file, thus, there is neither any delay nor any denial on the part CPIO. Therefore, no more action is required to be taken on the instant appeal and the same is hereby dismissed and disposed of accordingly.

So far as the other issues raised by the appellant in his 1<sup>st</sup> appeal are concerned, appellant is hereby advised to approach the appropriate platform as this act provides a mechanism for supplying only the available information to the appellant/applicant.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
