ORDER

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal through online RTI portal vide No. PODEP/A/E/22/00124 dated 08.11.2022 against the disposal of his RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/22/00826 dated 19.10.2022 by CPIO/North-East with the contentions that he has been provided Incomplete, Misleading or False information. His untraced claims have not been settled due to delay in providing the untraced report by the local police.

Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 19.10.2022 had sought information on 5 points regarding action taken by local police on e-FIR No. 000286 dated 04/07/2022 which was lodged online by him in connection with lost/theft of his Maruti Alto car No. DL-6CN-1269.

Comments of CPIO/North-East:-

To proceed further in the matter, comments of CPIO/North-East were sought, who submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office through online portal vide No. PODEP/R/E/22/00826 dated 19.10.2022 in which applicant sought information on 5 points regarding action taken by local police on e-FIR No. 000286 dated 04/07/2022 which was lodged online by him in connection with lost/theft of his Maruti Alto car No. DL-6CN-1269." In this regard ,report from SHO PS Manimajra was sought and point wise available information was supplied to the appellant vide letter No. 129/RTI/CPIO/North-East, dated 29.10.2022. Copy of statement as sought by applicant in point No.1 of RTI application was supplied to the applicant and regarding other points it was intimated that e-FIR was marked to ASI Paramjit Singh of PS-Manimajra for investigation. Inspite of making sincere efforts , when no clue of stolen vehicle came to light, then this e-FIR was sent as untraced through web portal. Applicant was also intimated vide e-mail dated 03.11.2022 that this e-FIR was sent as untraced through web portal and he can approach the Ld. Court of Mrs Gurdeep Kaur JMIC, Chandigarh for further proceedings.

Decision:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/North-East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that it has already been intimated by CPIO/North-East to the appellant that Inspite of making sincere efforts, when no clue of stolen vehicle came to light, then e-FIR No. 000286 dated 04/07/2022 was sent as untraced through web portal and he can approach the Ld. Court of Mrs Gurdeep Kaur JMIC, Chandigarh for further proceedings. As the available information has been provided to the appellant by CPIO/North-East, thus there was neither any delay nor any denial on the part of CPIO.

So far as the matter of delay in issuance of untraced report of stolen vehicle is concerned, SHO-e-FIR reported that there is some technical fault in the system of e-FIR portal and the matter is underway with the quarter concerned for resolving the issue.

Henceforth, SHO e-FIR-cum-I/C Computer Section is hereby directed to make all out efforts to streamline the online system of e-FIR portal at the earliest so that untrace reports can be issued to the complainants without delay. Accordingly, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
