ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 08.10.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 25.09.2024 by CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application has sought complete proceedings of complaint no. ICMS/2024/005901.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C CRU who reported that complaint bearing no. ICMS/2024/005901 is still under consideration. Hence, sought information was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act and appellant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 243/RTI/DSP/Admn dated 01.10.2024.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application has sought complete proceedings of complaint no. ICMS/2024/005901.

In reply, CPIO/Admn had denied the sought information as per the provisions of section 8(1)(h) of RTI Act.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/Admn has appropriately disposed of the RTI application as compliant no. ICMS/2024/005901 is still under consideration and hence, requisite information cannot be supplied at this stage also. However, considering the contentions of the appellant and to achieve the objectives of

the RTI Act, CPIO/Admn is hereby directed to provide the requisite information to the appellant if complaint is filed and no FIR is registered on the complaint, strictly as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
