#### **ORDER**

The appellant has preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 28.12.2022 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 26.10.2022 on the ground that information supplied to him by CPIO/South-west is not legible at the top left corner and have not been properly certified as per the mandate of para 2 of the office memorandum dated 06.10.2015 issued by DOPT,GOI, New Delhi.

### Information sought vide RTI application:

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 26.10.2022 had information on three (3) points i.e (i) Section of CrPC under which various 'Notice for Appearance' has been repeatedly issued to the applicant Vasu Sharma (ii) Inform FIR No./ Case No., date and the sections of IPC under which the FIR has been lodged/registered (iii) Provide a certified copy of the complaint/FIR registered against the applicant under section 2 (j)(ii) of the RTI Act, 2005 as per rules.

#### Comments of CPIO/South-West:-

CPIO/South-West vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office through CPIO/Hqrs on dated 10.11.2022 vide his office letter No. 684/CPIO/Hqrs/RTI-2022/D-955 dated 09.11.2022. Thereafter requisite point wise information was supplied to the applicant vide letter No. 208-RTI/CPIO/South-west, dated 30.11.2022. Certified copy of complaint bearing ICMS No. 2022/003663 dated 18.07.2022 containing 3 pages was also supplied to the applicant.

## Decision:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South-West vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that appellant vide his RTI application dated 26.10.2022 had sought information on 3 points pertaining to complaint bearing ICMS No. 2022/003663 dated 18.07.2022 which was duly and rightly supplied by CPIO/South-West.

Appellant vide his instant online 1<sup>st</sup> appeal attracted attention of the undersigned on the plea that copy of complaint supplied to him is not legible at the top left corner and the same is not properly certified as per the mandate of para 2 of the office memorandum dated 06.10.2015 issued by DOPT,GOI, New Delhi.

Henceforth, for the satisfaction of the appellant, CPIO/South-West is hereby directed to supply the legible copy of complaint after properly certifying the same as per the mandate of para 2 of the office memorandum dated 06.10.2015 issued by DOPT,GOI, New Delhi for proper disposal of his RTI application as per RTI Act.

With these directions, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi - 110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
