**ORDER**

**Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.**

This is an order on the online first appeal bearing No. PODEP/A/E/22/00056 dated 15.05.2022, preferred by Manish Kumar r/o H. No. 554, New Police Line, Sector-26, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005, received in this office through online RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System(RTI-MIS), against the disposal of his RTI Application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/22/00275 dated 21.04.2022 by CPIO/Accounts.

2) The appellant, vide his RTI application dated 21.04.2022 under RTI Act 2005, had requested Nodal Officer PHQ to supply him some information in 02 points, about the stationery of last 03 years demanded by Communication Wing and issued to them by Stationery Branch. Nodal Officer PHQ further transferred the CPIO/Communication on 21.04.2022. After perusal of RTI application CPIO/Communication transferred the same to CPIO/Accounts for its disposal being the custodian of the information. CPIO/Accounts disposed-of the online RTI application, vide No. 33/RTI-28/CPIO (Accts)2022/21566 dated 19.05.2022.

3) The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his application was disposed off, has filed the instant appeal alleging that the CPIO/Accounts provided incomplete information.


4) The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Accounts have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by the CPIO. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:-

However, grievances raised by the appellant in the appeal are different from the information sought in RTI application and the fresh information cannot be entertained in this appeal.
<b>Point No. 02</b> Provide moth wise stationary list which is given to communication wing by stationary branch in last 03 years. Provide both lists from stationary branch.
