ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 14.11.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 04.10.2024 by concerned CPIO/South with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 04 points i.e. Name of person who called the police on No. 100 or 112 or the information on which the police raided his residence, details of proceeding taken by police, names of police personnel who raided his residence and action taken by police on the complaint.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/South :-

CPIO/South vide his comments submitted that the RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS-34 and the same was supplied to the appellant vide letter No. 262/RTI-24/CPIO-South/UT/Chandigarh dated 17.10.2024.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/South vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 04 points i.e. Name of person who called the police on No. 100 or 112 or the information on which the police raided his residence, details of proceeding taken by police, names of police personnel who raided his residence and action taken by police on the complaint.

In reply, CPIO/South has supplied the sought information to the appellant vide letter No. 262/RTI-24/CPIO-South/UT/Chandigarh dated 17.10.2024.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/South has already provided the available information to the appellant. Hence, no more action is required on this first appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
