

**THE SENIOR SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE, HQs.- CUM-APPELLATE AUTHORITY,
COMMUNICATION, UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

ORDER

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the online first appeal bearing No. PODEP/A/E/22/00051 dated 14.05.2022, preferred by Manish Kumar r/o H. No. 554, New Police Line, Sector-26, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005, received in this office through online RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System(RTI-MIS), against the disposal of his RTI Application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/22/00223 dated 29.03.2022 by CPIO/Communication.

2) The appellant, vide his RTI application dated 29.03.2022 under RTI Act 2005, had requested, CPIO/Communication to supply him some information in 06 points, about the entry made by Const. Manish Kumar 1027/CP (applicant) in log book and duty deployment in Communication Wing. CPIO/Communication disposed-of the RTI application, vide No. RTI-28/DSP/Comn./UT, dated 26.04.2022.

3) The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his application was disposed off, has filed the instant appeal alleging that the CPIOs i.e. CPIO/Comm. and CPIO/Establishment has supplied misleading/incomplete information and has requested to provide the reply of 3,4,5 and 6th question of the RTI no. PODEP/R/E/22/00223.


4) The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Communication have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by the CPIO. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:-

Point No. 06 Give last three year details of how many numbers of entries made in Traffic Net Log book, shift wise, were made by how many persons rather than traffic net operator as per visible handwriting proof. (except on/off duty handwriting proof)	Point No. 06 Two such entries were reported to this office. 1. ASI Bhupinder Singh No. 2578/CP gave a written submission that Const. Manish Kumar No. 1027/CP made without his consent. A Special report in this regard was sent to Senior Officer to take necessary action. 2. ASI Balraj Rana No. 299/CP made entry of Traffic Net duty operator against ASI Birender Singh No. 261/CP. However, Inspector Communication found their action inappropriate and called explanation from both. They apologized in their submission and Inspector Communication warned them to be careful in future and the explanation was filed.		Point No. 06 CPIO/Communications has already supplied the information on this point.

5) The appeal is hereby disposed of accordingly.

6) The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal to the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
