ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 12.11.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 11.09.2024 by concerned CPIO/Admn with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing No. PW-202112149 i.e. copy of all complaints made by Smt. Monika Khanna, copy of all proceedings of the complaint and final report of the complaint.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that the RTI application was received in his office to obtain the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC and the same was supplied to the appellant containing 65 pages vide letter No. 176/RTI/DSP/Admn dated 19.11.2024.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding complaint bearing No. PW-202112149 i.e. copy of all complaints made by Smt. Monika Khanna, copy of all proceedings of the complaint and final report of the complaint.

In reply, CPIO/Admn has supplied the sought information to the appellant containing 65 pages vide letter No. 176/RTI/DSP/Admn dated 19.11.2024.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/Admn has already provided the available information to the appellant. Hence, no more action is required to be taken on this instant 1st appeal.

However, CPIO/Admn is hereby advised to dispose of the RTI application within the stipulated time period.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
