ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 27.11.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 30.09.2024 with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application had sought certified copies of all documents in regard to complaint bearing No. ICMS/2024/015699.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Admn :-

CPIO/Admn vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office for supplying the requisite information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from I/C CRU who reported that complaint bearing No. ICMS/2024/015699 is still under consideration and the same was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act. The appellant was informed accordingly vide letter No. 284/RTI-24/DSP/Admn dated 04.12.2024.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Admn vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application has sought certified copies of all documents in regard to complaint bearing No. ICMS/2024/015699.

In reply, CPIO/Admn had denied the sought information as per the provisions of section 8(1)(h) of RTI Act.

Now as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO/Admn has appropriately disposed of the RTI application as compliant no. ICMS/2024/015699 is still under enquiry

and the requisite information cannot be supplied at this stage also. Hence, no more action is required.

However, CPIO/Admn is hereby advised to dispose of the RTI application within the stipulated time period.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
