<u>ORDER</u>

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal dated 30.11.2023 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 27.10.2023 by CPIO/Hqrs with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 27.10.2023 had sought information regarding complaint bearing No. ICMS/2022/012282.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Hqrs :-

CPIO/Hqrs vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received through CAPIO/PHQ. Accordingly, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC who reported that complaint bearing No. ICMS/2022/012282 is consigned in with record after completion of enquiry. The applicant was informed telephonically as well as vide letter No. 643/CPIO/Hqrs/RTI-23, D-865 dated 29.11.2023 to visit the office of the undersigned for inspection of the file. Thereafter, on 29.11.2023, Mr. A.K. Dhadwal (Authorized person) visited the office and inspected the relevant record. However, after inspection, he left the office without collecting any documents.

DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Hqrs vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant had sought information.

In reply, CPIO/Hqrs gave the opportunity to the appellant to inspect the file/record, however, authorized person left the office without collecting the information.

Now, as far as the instant appeal is concerned, appellant has already been provided suitable time to inspect the relevant record of complaint No. ICMS/2022/012282 dated 28.10.2022. Thereafter, on 29.11.2023, authorized person inspected the relevant record and

also given inspection note but left without taking inspection receipt. However, for upholding the spirit of RTI act, CPIO/Hqrs is hereby directed to provide another opportunity for inspection of the record to the appellant and provide requisite information to the appellant in accordance with RTI act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
