ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 29.01.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 29.09.2023 by CPIO/Central with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 29.09.2023 had sought information regarding his complaint against Satish Suri and others.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Central:-

CPIO/Central vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS- 17 who reported that compliant bearing no. ICMS/2023/014978 has been registered upon his complaint and the same is still under enquiry. Hence, the same was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8(1) (h) of RTI Act, 2005 as complaint in question is still under enquiry. Applicant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 273/RTI-23/CPIO-Central/UT/dated Chandigarh the 24.10.2023.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information regarding his complaint against Satish Suri and others.

In reply, CPIO/Central denied the requisite information u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act as the complaint was under investigation at that time.

So far as present status of this case is concerned, the same is still under investigation and the sought information cannot be supplied at this stage also, hence, the same is denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
