**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal dated 12.12.2023 against the disposal of his online RTI application bearing No. PODEP/R/E/23/01039 dated 04.12.2023 by CPIO/Hqrs with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

**Information sought vide RTI application :-**

The appellant vide his RTI dated 04.12.2023 had sought information on 03 points regarding complaint bearing No. PW 2013-00516 i.e. copy of complaint, status of complaint and closure report.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/Hqrs :-**

CPIO/Hqrs vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office through online RTI portal to obtain the information regarding complaint No. PW 2013-00516. Accordingly, requisite information was obtained from I/C HAC who reported that complaint bearing No. PW 2013-00516 has already been destroyed in the year 2017 vide Order No. 9054-57/UT/HAC dated 25.09.2017. The same was apprised to the appellant vide letter No. 350/CPIO/Hqrs/ /RTI-23, D-302 dated 06.12.2023.

**DECISION :-**


I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Hqrs vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application has sought information on 03 points regarding complaint bearing No. PW 2013-00516 i.e. copy of complaint, status of complaint and closure report.

In reply, CPIO/Hqrs has already apprised the appellant that complaint bearing No. PW 2013-00516 has already been destroyed in the year 2017 vide Order No. 9054-57/UT/HAC dated 25.09.2017.

So far as the instant appeal is concerned, appellant has already been apprised by CPIO/Hqrs that complaint in question has been destroyed. However, to achieve the objectives of RTI Act, CPIO/Hqrs is hereby directed to provide copy of orders vide which complaint has been destroyed to the appellant.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
