

**THE SENIOR SUPERINTENDENT OF POLICE, HQs.- CUM-APPELLATE  
AUTHORITY, COMMUNICATION, UNDER RIGHT TO INFORMATION ACT, 2005.**

**ORDER**

**Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.**

This is an order on the online first appeal bearing No. PODEP/A/E/22/00078 dated 29/06/2022, preferred by Sh. Ajay Kumar r/o H.No 5067 GF, Sector-38 West, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005, received in this office through online RTI Request & Appeal Management Information System (RTI-MIS), against the disposal of his RTI Application dated 04/06/2022.

2) The appellant, vide his RTI application, bearing No. PODEP/R/E/22/00409 dated 04/06/2022 under RTI Act 2005, had requested, RTI Nodal Officer/PHQ to supply him some information in 03 points, pertaining to a visit of PCR at his Flat No. 5067, GF, Sector-38 West, Chandigarh. Nodal Officer, PHQ, further transferred the RTI application to CPIO/Communication, for disposal at his own level. CPIO/Communication disposed-of the RTI application, vide No. RTI-52/DSP/Comm./ UT dated 13.06.2022 and also transferred the RTI application to CPIO/South-West Division to supply part information & disposal at his own level.

3) The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which his application was disposed off, has filed the instant appeal alleging that CPIOs has provided incomplete, misleading or false information.

4) The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Communication have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Communication. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:-



<b>Point No. 1</b> As per enclosed picture of 30.05.2022 at near-about 11.20 PM, on what basis a PCR vehicle No. CH01GA6432 came to my house Flat No. 5067, GF, Sector-38 West, Chandigarh where I am living with my ailing father who is suffering from "Parkison illness" (Treatment from PGI Chandigarh). Please provide name, address and Phone Number of the caller and what information was given.	<b>Point No. 1</b> As per record available/maintained in Police Control Room, on 30.05.2022 at 23:24 hours, a call was received in Police Control Room, in which caller did not disclose his/her name and address, said that the need of ambulance at # 5067, GF, Sector-38 West, CHD. Immediately PCR vehicle Sugar 27 and Medical Ambulance 112 were sent on spot. ASI Rajesh Kumar 3056/CP, I/C PCR vehicle reported that sick Balkishan age 87 years R/o Flat No. 5067, GF, Sector-38 West, CHD. He said that he is already taking treatment from PGI and he was lifted to PGI along with his son Ajay Kumar age 51 years	Incomplete, misleading or false information provided.	On perusal of comments, the undersigned found that only point No. 01 and 02 of RTI application were dealt by CPIO/Communication. CPIO Commn. has also transferred the RTI application to CPIO/South-West division to supply part information. Therefore, the instant appeal has also been transferred to SSP/UT being First Appellate Authority w.r.t. CPIO/South West vide this office letter No. D-547/RTI/SSP/HQs. dated 02.07.2022 for disposal at his own level. <b>Decision of the undersigned being the First Appellate Authority Commn. is as under:-</b> The undersigned is agree with the information supplied by the CPIO/Commn. on point No 01 & 02. Decision w.r.t. CPIO/South West will be informed by the office of



	<p>r/o same and drop at PGI Emergency for help. Duty officer ASI Nand Kishore also informed. Beside this medical Ambulance 112 also reached on spot. EMT Sohan informed that patient already picked by PCR vehicle.</p> <p>However, mobile number of complainant could not be supplied as the same is exempted U/s 8 (1) (g) of RTI Act.</p>		SSP/UT-cum-FAA-South West Division.
<b>Point No. 2</b> Please provide complete information that where this PCR had dropped us.	<b>Point No. 2</b> As per record sick Balkishan age 87 years and his son Ajay Kumar dropped at PGI Emergency for help.		
<b>Point No. 3</b> What legal action can be taken when somebody gives wrong information to call PCR.	<b>Point No. 3</b> Dose not relate to communication wing. .		

5) The appeal is hereby disposed of.

6) The appellant, if not satisfied with the disposal of appeal in the manner as above can file second appeal to the Hon'ble Chief Information Commission, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munrika, New Delhi-110067 within a period of 90 days.
