O R D E R

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on an appeal dated 05.01.2022, preferred by Sh. Pardeep Sharma R/o # 3032, Sector- 35D, Chandigarh under RTI Act 2005 through e-mail dated 02.07.2022, against the disposal of his RTI Application, vide memo No. 296/CPIO/HQs./RTI-2022 D-575 dated 28.06.2022.

(2) The appellant, vide an email dated 11.05.2022 had submitted his application under RTI Act 2005, had requested House Allotment Branch CPIO/Chandigarh to supply him some information in 04 points in connection to house allotment done on 15th July 2014 to Sub. Insp. Pramajit Kaur, House No. 2702-A, Sector-42/C, Chandigarh. Superintendent, House Allotment Committee, U.T., Chandigarh has transferred the application to The CPIO, Director General of Police, U.T., Chandigarh, vide No. A5/2022/6642 dated 20.05.2022, which was further marked to DSP/HQs-cum-Nodal Officer (PHQ). DSP-cum-CPIO/Hqrs., has disposed the application on 22.06.2022 vide order No. 296/CPIO/Hqrs./RTI-2022 D-557. The appellant not satisfied with the information supplied to him by CPIO/Hqrs. (Procurement Branch), has filled instant appeal. The undersigned is the First Appellate Authority in respect of CPIO/Hqrs. (Procurement Branch).


(3) The comments of CPIO/Hqrs. (Procurement Branch) have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO.
