ORDER

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 05.02.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 26.12.2023 by CPIO/Central with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 26.12.2023 had sought information i.e. copy of statements signed by parties in complaint case of Ms. Kamla Devi.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/Central:-

CPIO/Central vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS- 17 who reported that complaint bearing no. ICMS/2023/024544 has been registered against the appellant and the same is still under enquiry. Hence, the same was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8(1) (h) of RTI Act, 2005 as complaint in question is still under enquiry. Applicant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 361/RTI-23/CPIO-Central/UT/dated 05.01.2024.

DECISION :-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/Central vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information i.e. copy of statements signed by parties in complaint case of Ms. Kamla Devi.

In reply, CPIO/Central denied the requisite information u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI Act as the complaint was under investigation at that time.

Now as far as appeal is concerned, as per the record of ICMS portal complaint bearing no. ICMS/2023/024544 has been consigned with HAC Branch after finalization of the enquiry. Therefore, CPIO/Central is hereby directed to provide the requisite information to the appellant as per the provisions of RTI Act.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
