ORDER

Order on First Appeal u/s 19 RTI Act.

This is an order on the First Appeal dated 02.09.2021, preferred by Dr. Renu Bala, 286 First Floor, Sector-12, Panchkula, Haryana under RTI Act 2005, received in this office on 02.09.2021, against the disposal of her RTI Application dated 22.07.2021.

- The appellant, vide her RTI application dated 22.07.2021 under RTI Act 2005, had requested, Central Public Information Officer, Communication to supply her some information on 02 points, pertaining to call made to Police helpline numbers 100,112, 1091 from 9463984854 on 14, march 2021. DSP-cum-CPIO (Comm.) received the RTI on 27.07.2021 vide No. 722/RTI/CAPIO (PHQ)/UT/PWS, for disposal at her own level being the custodian of the information. CPIO/Communication disposed-of the RTI application, vide No. RTI-83/DSP/Comn. Dated 02.08.2021.
 - (3) The appellant, not satisfied with the manner in which her application was disposed off, has filed the instant appeal alleging that CPIO/Comm. has supplied incomplete information on Point No. 01.
 - The comments of DSP-cum-CPIO/Communication have been called for. I have gone through the RTI appeal, vis-a-vis facts of the RTI application & comments by CPIO/Communication. The information sought by the appellant, supplied by the CPIO, grievance of the appellant and the order/decision of the undersigned being first appellate authority is given below:
