**ORDER**

The appellant has preferred 1<sup>st</sup> appeal against the reply/order of CPIO/PHQ in connection with his RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 17/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 28.02.2021 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

**INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-**

Appellant had sought information regarding information i.e. copy of statements recorded in complaint No. PW-2021-23896.

**COMMENTS OF CPIO/PHQ: -**

CPIO/PHQ submitted that appellant has filed RTI application for obtaining information, who reported that complaint in question was under enquiry, therefore denied u/s 8 (1) (h) of RTI Act and now the same has been sent to senior officers after completion of enquiry.

**DECISION :-**

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/PHQ vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant had filed the instant appeal against the



reply of CPIO/PHQ with regard to information related to complaint No. PW-2021-23896.

In reply, CPIO/PHQ has denied the requisite information as per section 8(1)(h) of RTI act as the complaint in question was under enquiry at that time.

Insofar as appeal is concerned; the complaint in question is still under consideration with the undersigned, therefore; the requisite information cannot be supplied at this stage. However, keeping in view that appellant being complainant in the complaint, therefore; CPIO/PHQ is hereby directed apprise the appellant about the current status of the complaint in question as per RTI Act. With these observations , appeal stands disposed of, accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
