ORDER

The appellant has preferred 1st appeal against the reply of CPIO/East in connection with her RTI application with the contentions that requisite information was not supplied to him. The instant appeal was diarized vide No. 32/UT/RTI/FAA/SSP dated 29.03.2022 for further proceeding under RTI Act.

## INFORMATION SOUGHT IN RTI APPLICATION:-

The appellant had sought information on 32 points pertaining to case FIR No. 43/2021, PS-I/A, UT, Chandigarh.

# COMMENTS OF CPIO/East: -

CPIO/East submitted that appellant has sought information through online RTI application. After obtaining report from SHO/PS- I/Area, appellant was informed vide No. 75/CPIO/East dated 15.03.2022 that information sought cannot be supplied and denied u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI act as Challan in the instant case FIR no. 43/2021, PS-I/A has already been submitted in the learned Court on 22.02.2022 and the same is under trial, hence record in question is not available with local police.

### DECISION:-

I have gone through the contents of RTI application & appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that CPIO has denied the information pertaining to FIR No. 43/2021, PS-I/Area u/s 8(1)(h) of RTI act.

Now, as far as the appeal is concerned, CPIO has submitted that challan in the case in question, has already been submitted before the Learned Court, so the requisite information can be sought from Learned Court. However, keeping in view the interest of justice, CPIO/East is hereby directed to arrange the inspection of the available record of police station and supplied the available information to the appellant, as per RTI act.

Moreover, appellant is also advised to contact the concerned Learned Court for obtaining remaining information, if any.

With these directions, appeal stand disposed of.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
