<u>ORDER</u>

The appellant has preferred his 1st appeal dated 21.08.2024 against the disposal of his RTI application dated 15.07.2024 by CPIO/East with the contentions that requisite information was not provided to him.

Information sought vide RTI application :-

The appellant vide his RTI application dated 15.07.2024 had sought information on 03 points certified copy of GD no. 20 dated 08.06.2024 registered at PS-26, Chandigarh, copy of call recording made at 100 and copy of MLC and FSL report.

COMMENTS OF CPIO/East:-

CPIO/East vide his comments submitted that RTI application of the appellant was received in his office to supply the information. Thereafter, requisite information was obtained from SHO PS- 26 who reported that sought information is third party and personal in nature. Hence, the same was denied to the appellant as per the provisions of section 8(1) (j) of RTI Act, 2005. Moreover, consent from concerned was obtained, who requested not to share the information and also applicant did not submitted any authority letter from neither the complainant nor the victim to obtain the requisite information. Applicant was apprised about the same vide letter No. 127-RTI/CPIO/East dated 01.08.2024.

DECISION:-

A STATE OF THE STA

I have gone through the contents of RTI application, appeal of the appellant, comments of CPIO/East vis-à-vis material available on record which revealed that the appellant vide his RTI application had sought information on 03 points certified copy of GD no. 20 dated 08.06.2024 registered at PS-26, Chandigarh, copy of call recording made at 100 and copy of MLC and FSL report.

As far as appeal is concerned, CPIO/East has appropriately denied the requisite information u/s 8(1) (j) of RTI Act after taking consent from the concerned party, information being third party and personal in nature. Hence, no more action is required to be taken upon this instant appeal.

With these observations, instant appeal stands disposed off accordingly.

In case, the appellant is not satisfied with the disposal of his appeal, he can file second appeal before the Hon'ble CIC, CIC Bhawan, Baba Gangnath Marg, Munirka, New Delhi-110067 under the RTI Act within 90 days.
